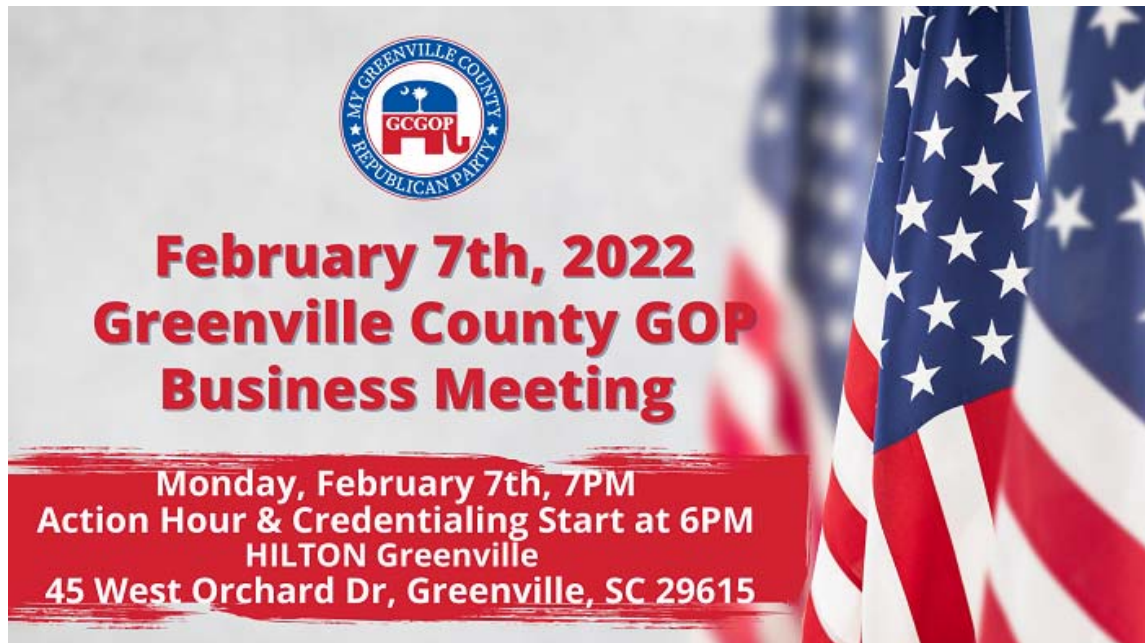

## Censure of U.S. Senator Lindsey Graham (R) RE Shooting Citizens in The Head

**Whereas** US citizens were lured inside the people's capitol building and have now been sitting in jail for months and an unarmed person was shot, Ashley Babbitt, was shot and killed, and,

**Whereas** Senator Graham at a Saturday, October 2<sup>nd</sup>, 2021, public Question & Answer session, organized by our sister organization, the Dorchester County Republican Party, discussing among other things the events of the January 6<sup>th</sup>, 2021 in Washington D.C., Senator Graham publicly stated:

**“If it had been up to me, I would have  
shot some of these people in the head”,**

and,

**Whereas** the only reason someone would want to shoot people in the head is to make sure they die, Senator Graham was publicly suggested killing US Citizens without due process, and,

**Whereas** this behavior is unbecoming of any human being, especially one elected and representing the citizens of South Carolina who are extremely friendly and would never agree to this kind of heartless remark.

**Therefore**, be it resolved that the Greenville County Republican Party condemns the notion of shooting unarmed citizens and hereby censures U.S. Senator Lindsey Graham as a representative of the Great State of South Carolina.
