SOUTH CAROLINA COMMERCIAL LEASE AGREEMENT

(Tenancy from month to month - 15 Day Termination Notice)

I. THE PARTIES. This South Carolina Commercial Lease Agreement ("Agreement") made on January 1, 2022, by and between:

Lessor: 1776 Services, LLC, with a mailing address of 2505 Wade Hampton Blvd, Greenville, SC 29615 ("Lessor"), and

Lessee: Greenville County Republican Party, with a mailing address of P.O. Box 25216, Greenville, SC 29616 ("Lessee"),

and collectively shall be known as the "Parties", agree as follows:

- II. DESCRIPTION OF LEASED PREMISES. The Lessor agrees to lease <u>non-exclusive use and common area access</u> to the Lessee of the building, garage and all grounds located at 2505 Wade Hampton Boulevard, Greenville, SC 29615, hereinafter known as the "Premises."
- III. USE OF LEASED PREMISES. The Lessee agrees to use the Premises for all purposes legal under law.
- IV. TERM OF LEASE. The term of this Agreement shall be a tenancy from month to month and terminable by any party with 15 days written notice prior to the end of any month. The Initial Term and the Renewal Periods shall be collectively referred to as the "Term."
- V. SECURITY DEPOSIT. There shall be no deposit required for the successful performance of this Agreement ("Security Deposit").
- VI. RENT. The monthly payment shall be One Thousand, Two Hundred Fifty dollars (\$1,250.00) payable monthly with the first payment due upon the commencement of this Agreement and each monthly installment payable thereafter on the 10th day of each month after the Initial Term ("Rent").

VII. LATE FEE. None.

VIII. EXPENSES.

Lessee is only responsible for the monthly rent payment and appropriate <u>liability</u> <u>insurance</u> for their use of the Premises as mutually agreed upon by the Parties.

Lessor shall be responsible for all other expenses and upkeep on the premises, including maintaining the general exterior structure of the Premises, all major systems such as the heating, plumbing, and electrical. The parking area shall be maintained by the Lessor, as well as the grounds and lands surrounding the Premises.

IX. LEASEHOLD IMPROVEMENTS. Any and all leasehold improvements made to the Premises which become affixed or attached to the leasehold Premises shall remain the property of the Lessor at the expiration or termination of this Agreement. Furthermore, any leasehold improvements shall be made only in accordance with applicable federal, state, or local codes, ordinances, or regulations, having due regard for the type of construction of the building housing the subject leasehold Premises. If the Lessee makes any improvements to the Premises the Lessee shall be responsible payment.

X. SUBLET / ASSIGNMENT. Lessee has no right to sublet or assign this Agreement.

XI. GOVERNING LAW. This Agreement shall be governed by the laws of the State of South Carolina.

WHEREAS the use of such differentiated logos, specifically the "TRUMP Hair' has brought the GCRP national press attention; and


WHEREAS it has been reported that President TRUMP himself and his family members have expressed pleasure at the "TRUMP Hair" differentiated logo; and


WHEREAS the GCRP Executive Board APPROVED the use of the "TRUMP HAIR" differentiated logo in August 2021,








Resolution of the GCRP RE Return of Facebook Page & Other Assets


WHEREAS it has been determined that the former Greenville County Republican Party ("GCRP") Chairman has absconded with the GCRP Facebook Page; and

WHEREAS other tangible and intangible assets of the GCRP have been absconded with, allegedly turned over to the SCGOP, and not returned to the GCRP;

NOW THEREFORE, be it resolved that the GCRP Party State Executive Committeeman is instructed to immediately raise this issue with the SCGOP and criminal and civil authorities to seek the return of the GCRP Facebook Page and all other assets of the GCRP, and to report back to the GCRP Executive Board by March 21st, 2022, for further action and direction.

RE: NOTICE TO PRESERVE EVIDENCE

Dear Ms. Spragins:

I understand that you are the registered agent for GMG Holdings, Inc. and that entity was the landlord for the Greenville County Republican Party (GCRP) offices at 850 Wade Hampton Boulevard.

NOTICE TO PRESERVE EVIDENCE

This letter is also a formal request that you preserve and not alter any data, lease documents or other potential evidence related to the above referenced lease, the GCRP, and the SALE OF THE PROPERTY (including communications with the purchaser), or any representative of the GCRP, including but not limited to Nate Leupp, Hal Roach, Esq. and Scott Stephens. This includes, but is not limited to, all communications or other documents, whether paper, electronic or otherwise stored, related to said matters in any way.

REQUIREMENT TO RETAIN ALL EVIDENCE. A number of court decisions have permitted court sanctions or "destruction of evidence" lawsuits where a party permanently alters important evidence after receiving written notice of a claim that also requests preservation of evidence. Unless I have your written explanation to the contrary within five business days from the date of this letter, I will presume you will strictly abide by all requests outlined above.



INTRODUCTION: During the March / April 2021 Greenville County Republican Party (GCRP) bi-annual precinct reorganization process, as required by statute, a substantial amount of apparent fraud was uncovered. This includes various rules violations, \$7,200 of missing funds and at least 360 "harvested" ballots, as detailed in the attached initial investigative report. See Exhibit A. Following the presentation of this unanimous report on July 6th, 2021, the GCRP Chairman, 1st Vice & Executive Committeeman all resigned two days later.

LEASE DOCUMENTS

Since no documentation or paperwork has been turned over to the newly elected leadership of the GCRP, I would like to request the following information related to the above matter.

- 1. All Lease Documents with the GCRP (including any drafts) covering 2020-2021.
- 2. All 2021 Invoices.
- 3. All 2021 Payment Records.
- 4. All records related to any increase in the rent, specifically the "back rent payment" of \$2,037.38 made on or about April 12, 2021 by the GCRP to GMG Holdings, Inc.

MOTION TO PROVIDE DIRECT INSTRUCTIONS TO THE GCRP CHAIRMAN IN REGARD TO THE POLICIES OF THE GREENVILLE COUNTY REPUBLICAN PARTY CONCERNING COMMUNICATIONS ON ITS BEHALF

WHEREAS the Executive Committee of the Greenville County Republican Party ("GCRP") is the only authority to set policy on behalf of the GCRP, and the GCRP Chairman is to be the only official spokesman of the GCRP (Rule 4(A)(3) of the GCRP Rules); and

WHEREAS it has recently come to the attention of the elected and appointed officers of the GCRP that the Chairman has been signing letters and issuing statements, purportedly on behalf of the GCRP, giving formal Notice to persons, offices, or corporate entities to Preserve Evidence, or to provide documents and information pursuant to the Freedom of Information Act (FOIA), without authorization of the GCRP Executive Committee; and

WHEREAS these communications have often been issued on documents not reflecting the official logo of the GCRP, but rather a similar appearing logo, generally employing the same color scheme, but generally with the word "MY" proceeding "Greenville County", or containing an image of "Trump Hair", or sometimes both; and

WHEREAS it is injurious to the GCRP brand, and potentially puts the GCRP Executive Committee at legal risk for the Chairman to take actions and make public statements that have not been authorized by the GCRP;

NOW THEREFORE, the GCRP Executive Committee clearly sets and states the policy of the GCRP in regard to the use of its logo, and the issuance of quasi-legal notices or document requests, or any other statements purportedly issued on its behalf by the GCRP Chairman, hereby directing the Chairman to conform all of his actions, and the actions of any other agents of the GCRP under his authority, to comply with the stated policy of the GCRP as follows:

- 1) No letter, email, written or oral communication shall be issued by the Chairman, or any other officer or agent of the GCRP, demanding that any person, legal entity, office, or officer Preserve Evidence, without the express authorization of the GCRP Executive Committee;
- 2) No letter, email, written or oral communication shall be issued by the Chairman, or any other officer or agent of the GCRP, demanding that any person, legal entity, office or officer respond to a Freedom of Information Act request, whether based on federal or state law, without the express authorization of the GCRP Executive Committee;
- 3) That any written or graphic communication on behalf of the GCRP, of any nature or description, including, but not limited to letterhead, emails, direct mail, and any online presence or online communications, specifically to include the GCRP website, shall contain only the official GCRP logo, unless expressly authorized by the GCRP Executive Committee; and further
- 4) The GCRP Chairman is hereby instructed to be cautious and wise in the choice of his words in any public statement on behalf of the GCRP, to ensure that any such public statement is consistent with the policy of the GCRP, and is not libelous or slanderous, potentially putting the GCRP Executive Committee, or its members, at risk of legal liability.





Office Space (2505 Wade Hampton Blvd) Details

 Proposed office location in same neighborhood as former GCRP HQ, but much more visible and useful for the Mission of the new GCRP because of attributes and resources of co-tenants

 Space included in lease is 1500 sq/ft available to GCRP for meetings, storage, our retail goods, events but as space will be multi-tenant hoteling practices will apply to common areas (reservations)

 GCRP <u>could not have been and was not</u> committed to any ownership or remodeling obligations.

Office Space (2505 Wade Hampton Blvd) Details

- Commercial Search website shows office space listings in the area ranging from \$8-\$18/sq ft or \$1000-2250/month based on 1500 sq ft which would not include utilities, as our lease proposal does
- GCRP will have access to multi media equipment donated by other tenants
- Owners Commercial Occupancy permit is in process. Note that unknown person(s) filed complaint with County regarding upgrades at property but inspectors have visited and issues resolved.

Office Space (2505 Wade Hampton Blvd) Details

 GCRP will have sub lease with chair Jeff Davis who has lease agreement with property owner. All relevant documents have been shared with Executive Board

 Lease is structured such that GCRP outlay is budgeted amount of \$1250/month rent and utilities, plus necessary liability insurance

 Space is ideal for the expanded mission of the GCRP and supports the Conservative Chamber of Commerce Philosophy

Office Space (2505 Wade Hampton Blvd) Summary

 we need a space to fulfill our Mission, and this is an amazing space with lots of potential exposure every day

we cannot get a deal this good anywhere else

 The proposal for rental space is a month-by-month lease so GCRP can exit easily with a vote if concerns arise
