The regular bi-monthly Business Meeting of the GREENVILLE COUNTY REPUBLICAN PARTY was held on Monday, June 3, 2024, at 7:00 PM, at Mauldin First Baptist Church, 150 S Main St, Mauldin, SC 29662 with the Chairman and the Secretary present. The minutes from the April 1, 2024, business meeting were approved.

Candidate guest speakers, Garey Collins, Frank Farmer, Ethan Jedziniak, Kelly Long, Curt McGahhey, Alex Reynolds, and Jay Rogers spoke.

Credentialing Committee Chair/EC Westside, Joe McLaughlin, reported a quorum was met with 82 precincts represented, which included 8 proxies.

Treasurer, Mary Wheeler, went over the Treasurer's report for the month of April and May, 2024. (Reports received and placed on file.)

Legislative Action Committee Chair/EC Simpsonville 6, Harrison Musselwhite, gave an update on the Health Czar (S915) bill.

Chairman Yvonne Julian gave the Chairman's report. (Report received and placed on file.)

Greenville 25 EC, Griffin Callahan, read the temporary policy and made a motion to adopt the Temporary Policy to Adopt Social Media Rules. (Resolution received and placed on file.) Discussion ensued. Piedmont EC, Steve Hudson, called the question. EC Tubbs Mountain, Gregory Peck, moved for a roll call vote, which passed by acclamation. Roll call vote (which has been received and placed on file) was conducted by Credentialing Committeemen, Heather Sheen and Joe McLaughlin, with a final vote of 60 yes and 14 no. The motion passed.

Moore Creek EC, Diana Weir, read the resolution and made a motion to censure Mountain Creek EC, Jonathan Bright, for violating county party rule 4A.3. (Resolution received and placed on file.) Discussion ensued. Ware Place EC, Julie Hershey, made a motion to suspend voting on this resolution until Jonathan Bright can be in attendance to defend himself. The motion did not pass. Parliamentarian, Ray Sheen, clarified that there will be no vote on this resolution tonight as Jonathan Bright is considered an elected official as per the rules. This resolution will need to be voted on at the next regular meeting.
