Attendance and Credentialing

Credentialing kicked off around 5:30 p.m., handled by the Credentialing Committee (thanks to Joe McLaughlin from the Westside EC for leading that effort). We quickly confirmed a quorum was in place, and by the end, we had 91 credentialed voting members ready to go.

Call To Order

We opened with an invocation and Scripture reading from Deborah McLemore (EC Saluda), who shared from Jude and offered a heartfelt prayer for unity in our party and for exposing any agitators who might try to cause division.

A few quick announcements followed, including a reminder about Jerry Tusso's swearing-in ceremony the next day (January 13 at 5:45 p.m. in Simpsonville).

Councilman-Elect Jerry Tusso (EC Simpsonville 4) led us in the Pledge of Allegiance after taking a moment to thank everyone who helped him win his recent election in Simpsonville.

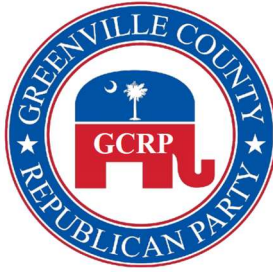
Mark Lawrence (EC Greenville 4) then led the group in reciting the Republican Creed.

We also reviewed the upcoming calendar: Legislative Tuesdays, the January 13 visitors and swearing-in events, the January 19 Pro-Life event, a February 9 presentation on socialism, the February 10 special meeting, the February 16 Spartanburg Gala, and an April ball game outing.

Guest Speakers

Mike Burkhold – Candidate for SC Comptroller General

Mike, a Chapin native and College of Charleston grad, shared his story: he ran for Congress back in 1998, founded and later sold a successful medical claims technology company (Equiscript), and now calls Sullivan's Island home.



He's running because he was stunned by recent state scandals—like \$3 billion double-booked and \$1.8 billion in errors—and wants to bring his business experience to modernize the office.

His vision: Treat the Comptroller's role like the state's "CFO," working closely with the legislature, governor, and treasurer. He'd push for real-time online access to the books (down to department and month level), use AI to spot patterns in the 268,000 monthly invoices for fraud detection and red-flagging, and fix a weak executive structure, outdated 20-year-old systems, chronic understaffing, and bureaucracy overload.

He estimates we're losing 5–10% to waste and could redirect another 20% with better priorities. Ultimately, he wants to clean up the culture (including unresolved issues from a 2012 audit), enable meaningful tax relief, and help make South Carolina the "freest, best-run state."

In Q&A, he explained AI excels at finding patterns (though not replacing core bookkeeping), pledged full visibility on federal funds, and committed to citizen oversight. The crowd really responded well—he even joked about being a "geeky accountant," which landed perfectly.

David Pascoe – Candidate for SC Attorney General

David, a Citadel '89 grad with 33 years as a prosecutor, reminded everyone of his role as special prosecutor in Probegate, where he helped convict the former Speaker, Senate Pro Tem, majority leaders, and judiciary chair amid massive corruption.

His core message: Government should serve the people, not insiders—and tolerating corruption only invites more evil. He recapped Probegate's challenges (biased judges, reluctant prosecutors, smear campaigns like those from Adam Piper), how the grand jury exposed corruption, weak ethics laws, and dark money, only to be halted by the SC Supreme Court.

He pulled no punches on the "swamp": lawyer-legislators as "monsters" and consultants as "parasites" who enrich insiders through bipartisan schemes. He called out Adam Piper specifically (former Quinn/AG deputy, now with Pennant LLC and Coaches vs. Overdoses, RAGA director) for alleged dark money attacks on Pascoe and a Miami RAGA event meet-up with opponents.

He referenced an October 2025 whistleblower complaint (8–10 pages) against the AG's office, which Senate Oversight supposedly buried, plus questions about litigation retention profits going to committee members and friends. He also criticized the Child ID Program Act of 2022—good idea on paper (ID kits for K-12), but poorly executed ("garbage," overpriced), with potential profiteering ties to Piper's entities.

His promise: Finish the Probegate work, launch Day One investigations if elected, and make 2026 transformative. He delivered it all with slides, some humor (including an AI-generated beach photo), and the session was live-streamed.



Approval of Agenda

Diana Weir (EC Moore Creek) motioned to approve the agenda, it was seconded, and the group approved it without objection.

Reports

State EC Report (Yvonne Julian)

The state party remains a continuing body with a big focus on fundraising and pushing partisan registration (preferring H.3643 to avoid mass re-registration). Recent resolutions covered closed primaries, appreciation for Musk and Kirk, pharma liability, and small business freedom (HB 3021).

They're seeing 77K new Republican movers (Horry County leading), rolling out demographic profiles, and Tyson Grinstead is on the Nominating Committee. Pickens was reinstated smoothly, but Greenville's chair reinstatement is tabled indefinitely.

Q&A touched on halted new-mover lists, H.3643 eligibility concerns (potential to bar Pascoe), and calls for better access and independent data tools.

Chairman's Report (Jeff Davis)

Jeff celebrated recent wins: Lee Bright in the Senate and Jerry Tusso in Simpsonville (though the Greenville city flip didn't happen).

Looking ahead: Heavy recruitment for the March 16–30 filing window (House seats and constitutional offices). The February 10 special meeting will cover budget, virtual amendments, and electing a new 1st Vice Chair (after Mike Voaden's resignation)—it'll be hybrid.

On a personal note, Jeff shared he's in his final round of chemotherapy and feeling optimistic. Key dates: Legislature starts Dec 13 (wait, likely meant upcoming session), primaries June 9, school board elections Nov 3 (6 of 12 seats up), reorg March 1/27.

Big agenda items: Closed primaries (bills 3310/4520), school choice (Trump tax credit 2027), judicial reform (S.696/H.4755), and pro-life pill enforcement. Goals include hitting 5,000 members, strong precinct work, and better conservative coordination.



Treasurer's Report (Mary Wheeler)

Starting balance: \$11,386.43 Income: \$6,242.28 (dues \$234.40, fundraising \$3,207.70, promotional outreach \$2,818) Expenses: \$1,776.25 (fundraising \$71.37, outreach \$369.53, rent/utilities \$1,300, website \$35.35)
Ending balance: \$15,852.46

The Christmas party was a success: \$7,923.34 in income, ~\$3,658.72 in expenses, netting \$4,264.69.

New Business

- Agenda approval: Motion passed without objection (voice vote, unanimous).
- October 9 minutes amendment: Added quorum numbers; passed by voice vote.
- Rules amendment proposal (allow electronic/hybrid for EC and committees, keep quarterly in-person): Sparked debate over past fraud concerns (2021) and transparency. A motion to amend failed, tabling failed, and a roll call vote (via blue sheets) was taken—but results weren't announced before we had to adjourn due to library closing time.

Adjournment

Motion by Michael Kilgore, seconded; passed by voice vote around 9:00 p.m.

Action Items

- Attend January 13 events and the February 10 special meeting.
- Recruit strong candidates for House, constitutional offices, and school board.
- Keep an eye on key bills (closed primaries, judicial reform, school choice).
- Push for better access to new movers' data.
- Explore sponsoring a venue for ~\$1,800 to allow longer meetings without rushing.

Role Call Vote Results

The rules amendment on electronic/hybrid meetings failed as it required a two-thirds majority vote. Due to the meeting running long, many members had already left before the vote took place.

Resolution to Amend the Rules of the Greenville County Republican Party

WHEREAS, 21st century technology has resulted in the common use of teleconferencing and web-based conferencing meetings.

WHEREAS, Robert's Rules 9-30 states; "Except as authorized in the bylaws, the business of an organization or board can be validly transacted only at a regular or properly called meeting - that is as defined in 8:2(1), a single official gathering in one room or area - of the assembly of its members at which a quorum is present."

WHEREAS, the current "Rules of the Greenville County Republican Party" do not provide for either virtual or electronic meetings,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, to amend the rules by adding a new

paragraph:

Rule 3 – Meetings, Section A - Regular Meetings, Paragraph (new)

Except as otherwise provided in these bylaws, meetings of the County Executive Committee and any standing committee or special committee may be conducted through use of teleconferencing, internet/web meeting service, in-person or a combination of these methods as designated by the Chairman. The electronic communications platforms must support visible displays identifying those participating so as to establish a quorum, identifying those seeking recognition to speak, showing (or permitting the retrieval of) the text of pending motions, and showing the results of votes. These electronic meetings shall be subject to all rules adopted by the Executive Committee to govern them, which may include any reasonable limitations on, and requirements for, members' participation. An anonymous vote conducted through the designated Internet meeting services shall be deemed a ballot vote, fulfilling any requirement in the bylaws or rules that a vote be conducted by ballot.
